- Promoting employee awareness, competence, participation, and accountability regarding energy performance.
- Reducing auxiliary energy consumption while maintaining safe, reliable, and environmentally compliant operations.
- Maximising net power export through optimisation of plant processes and equipment performance.
- Supporting the organisation's sustainability objectives and commitment to responsible resource utilisation.

The Energy Policy shall be communicated to all personnel working under the organisation's control and shall be reviewed periodically to ensure continued relevance to the organisation's strategic direction and operational needs.



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
